

Report on the activities of the International Association of Francophone Prosecutors (IAFP)

Since the first General Meeting of the International Association of Francophone Prosecutors (IAFP), which was held on Wednesday 9th September 2009 at Kiev during the IAP annual conference, our young association is structuring and developing its activities.

First, in the frame of its relations with OIF, (Organisation Internationale de la Francophonie), different events were organised, for example our Secretary General went in Tunis at a meeting about rights of children, and made an intervention. It plans too for a participation of the francophone association at a meeting concerning the 10th anniversary of the Declaration of Bamako, next May; our President will come in Paris for this occasion. IAFP wishes to bring its assistance for another project of OIF, it concerns the situation of Haiti. IAFP has proposed to bring legal documentation, I. hardware, and to develop cooperation's mission in sending experts in the country.

Then, IAFP implicates in activities of others networks, for example, it will attend, by the person of its President a meeting of AHJUCAF(Association des Hautes juridictions de cassation des pays ayant en partage l'usage du français), in Ottawa, Quebec, in June, about Internationalization of Law and Justice.

IAFP, in its relations with IAP, is continuing to translate the Newsletters, and the French translation brief guide has been done, the 2nd edition of the IAP Human Rights will be translate and incorporate in the first in the coming mouths.

With the assistance of the IAP Manager of communication, IAFP is restoring and developing its website until it is completely working, meantime, the e-mails exchanges are promoting between the members. New website will includes information about membership, coming events, law documentation, expertises...

With the support of OIF, francophone participants coming from Africa, Asia, Middle East, will assist IAP Annual Conference to The Hague, and it will have the opportunity too to hold the 2nd General Meeting of the francophone association during this important event, in making an inventory of fixtures and in bringing out the next guidelines for its futur activities.
