Mr Tan Siong Thye graduated with a Bachelor of Laws (Honours) from the National University of Singapore in 1979 and obtained a Masters of Law (with Merit) from University College London in 1992. - Director of the Commercial Affairs Department – 1999 to 2008
- Senior State Counsel of the Attorney-General’s Chambers – 1998 to 1999
- District Judge of the State Courts – 1986 to 1998
- Deputy Public Prosecutor of the Attorney-General’s Chambers – 1979 to 1986

He assumed the office of Deputy Attorney-General on 2 February 2015.

He was a member of the Military Court of Appeal and was also a field army commander with the rank of Colonel (Reservist) in the Singapore Armed Forces.
