Olivier CHRISTEN is 43; he is a magistrate of the judiciary, in France.

In 1999, after studying at the National School of Magistrates, he was appointed investigation judge (“juge d’instruction“) of Court of Appeal of PONTOISE.

Then, he joined central government, first in 2002, the Criminal Affairs and Pardons Division of Ministry of Justice where he was assigned to the Office of the fight against organized crime and terrorism, and in 2004, as the Head of the department of standardization work of the Secretariat General of Government (Prime Minister's Office).

In 2007, he became vice-president in charge of investigation of Tribunal de Grande Instance of Bobigny, then, in 2008, he became the Secretary General of this same court.

From 2010 to 2014, he was a vice-prosecutor of the Tribunal de Grande Instance de Paris where he led the Anti-terrorism Division.

Since January 2014, Olivier CHRISTEN is the Deputy Director of Criminal Justice Department in specialized areas whose organized crime, in Criminal Affairs and Pardons Division of the French Ministry of Justice.
