Han Moraal was appointed National Member for the Netherlands at Eurojust in June 2014. His first appointment was as a Public Prosecutor with the Public Prosecution Service in 1987 in Rotterdam, from where he moved in 1994 to the Zwolle Lelystad District Court. In 1996, Han Moraal was appointed Chief Public Prosecutor to the Flevoland police region, and in 1998, was appointed Chief Public Prosecutor at Groningen District Court. In 2007, following four years as Chief Public Prosecutor at The Hague District Court, he was appointed Prosecutor-General to the Board of Prosecutors-General. After that he served as National Chief Advocate General.
