

**BRIAN J. SAUNDERS** is the Director of Public Prosecutions and head of the Public Prosecution Service of Canada, a position he has held since May 28, 2009. Prior to being appointed Director, Mr. Saunders served as the Acting Director of Public Prosecutions from December 12, 2006 when the *Director of Public Prosecutions Act* came into force establishing the Public Prosecution Service of Canada.

Before assuming these duties, Mr. Saunders held various positions within the federal Department of Justice including Assistant Deputy Attorney General of Canada (Citizenship, Immigration and Public Safety) and Senior General Counsel and Director General of the Ottawa Civil Litigation Section. He has acted as counsel on cases at all levels of court in Canada including the Supreme Court of Canada.

Mr. Saunders is a co-author of *Federal Courts Practice*, an annual publication since 1988, and of the *Crown Liability and Proceedings Act 2014*.

Mr. Saunders has a B.A. and an LL.B. from the University of Alberta and an LL.M. and a Diploma in Legal Studies from Cambridge University.
