










ABSENCE OF COUNTRY BY COUNTRY REPORTING IS A THIRD PROBLEM







NEED FOR AUTOMATIC INFORMATION EXCHANGE IS A MATTER OF URGENCY











RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES
