RULES FOR SUBMITTING ARTICLES

Articles should be sent to <revistaacademica.esmp@mpce.mp.br> up to **March, 17, 2019** for publication in the next edition (Year 11, Number 1 [July, 2019]). They will be selected by the ESMP Academic Journal Editorial Board through a double-blind, peer-reviewed process.

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

1. Articles can be written in Portuguese, English or Spanish and should *preferably* be between **2,000 and 4,000 words**, including title, abstract, keyword and references. Articles written in Portuguese and Spanish should have title, abstract and keywords in English.
2. Articles should be sent in Microsoft Word format, extensions ".doc" or ".docx", Times New Roman font.
3. Body text should contain Introduction, Development, Conclusion and References.
4. References of articles must follow the rules of style commonly adopted by law journals in the author's country.
5. The ESMP staff should proceed with modifications in articles, under authorization by authors, in order to adapt their formats to the ESMP Academic Journal standards and their references to the ABNT rules.
