



Glossary

Botnet:

A network of computers that have been infected by malicious software. This network can be activated to perform specific actions such as analysing large amounts of research data or attacking information systems.

Denial of service (DOS) attacks

DOS attacks are attempts to render a computer system unavailable to users often by bombarding the target computer or network with communication requests

Distributed Denial of Service (DDOS) attacks



I asked Daniel to tell me about his career in cybercrime:

"I graduated in spring 2007 from the University of Zurich in Switzerland with a Master's Degree in Law. I worked as a State Notary's Office and a State Prosecutor in the Canton of Saint Gallen in Switzerland. In April 2011 I started working as a Prosecutor for the State Prosecutions Office of the Canton of Saint Gallen. In addition I also hold a Master's degree in criminal investigation from the University of Applied Sciences in Advanced Studies in Forensics, University of Applied Sciences. My daily work involves a wide kind of criminal cases, from offences against public order to violent crime to sexual crime to drug related crime. I was the youngest prosecutor in my office for quite some time (I was elected as a prosecutor at the age of 27, fortunately by now there are also younger colleagues) and because of my interest in Information Technology I was appointed by my superior to investigate ICT related cases. In this regard I created a small manual for my colleagues for ICT related investigations.

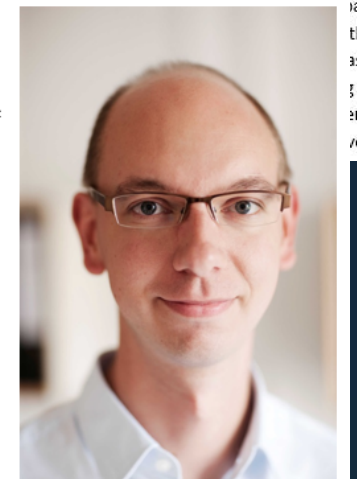

Lars Lichtenstein started his career as Head of Section at the Danish Ministry of Justice in 2001 where he mainly dealt with legislative work – primarily within the field of criminal law. In 2004 he moved to the Parliamentary Ombudsman who investigates complaints about the public administration. After entering the prosecution service in 2005 he was appointed Senior Prosecutor in the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

Currently he deals with criminal law and criminal procedure at a more theoretical level, for example: taking part in the legislative process, assisting the local police districts in complex matters and working with the cooperation between the police and the prosecution service. Lars has also been part of a number of national forums and working groups concerning the investigation and prosecution of cybercrime, especially child abuse cases where, on several occasions he has advised the Council of Europe as an expert.
