# 1. In acknowledgement of the increasing risk and incidence of attacks and murders of prosecutors in the course of their duties,

- encourage state authorities to provide protection and security to prosecutors to enable them to perform their duties without fear of harm or death in accordance with Article 5 of the United Nations Guidelines on the Role of Prosecutors and the Declaration on Minimum Standards concerning the Security and Protection of Public Prosecutors adopted by the IAP in 2008.
- support a worldwide 'Exploratory Study of Targeted Attacks on Prosecutors' being conducted in collaboration with IAP to assess the number, type and locus of such attacks and attempted attacks in order to raise awareness of the risks faced by prosecutors and support action by state authorities to provide for their protection and security.
