

Biographical note: Nikoloz Chinkorashvili

Nikoloz Chinkorashvili is the Deputy Head of the International Relations and Legal Department at the Office of the Prosecutor General of Georgia. He is in charge of cooperation with international organizations and implementation of international standards at the Prosecution Service, including in the areas of prosecutorial independence, asset tracing and recovery, fighting corruption, money laundering and terrorism financing. He is also responsible for cooperation with OLAF and Asset Recovery Offices.

Previously, for more than five years, Nikoloz Chinkorashvili used to supervise money laundering and other financial crimes investigations and prosecutions at the Prosecution Service, when serving as a head of the Anti-Money Laundering Unit of the Financial Crimes Supervision Department and later as a deputy head of this department. His career also included working on MLA and extradition cases as a prosecutor for around four years.

Nikoloz Chinkorashvili has considerable experience in participating, as both country representative and an evaluator, in international peer reviews, including those conducted by Moneyval, GRECO and OECD ACN, assessing anti-money laundering, combating terrorism financing and anti-corruption systems respectively.

Nikoloz Chinkorashvili was born on 26 April 1983. He has a wife and two children.
