



Jennifer Harrower is the Deputy Head of the Local Court function within the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service (COPFS), Scotland's prosecution and deaths investigation service. Local Court has responsibility for the prosecution of summary cases and cases prosecuted on indictment before a sheriff and jury.

Jennifer joined COPFS in 1988 and has worked in a wide range of roles, spanning a number of geographical areas as well as specialist roles. Before taking up her post in Local Court, Jennifer was Procurator Fiscal for Specialist Casework, holding responsibility for organised crime, financial crime and proceeds of crime cases throughout Scotland.
