

Summary Bio of Mr. Tai Wei Shyong



- Mr Tai Wei Shyong is the current Deputy Attorney-General. He was appointed and assumed office as Deputy Attorney-General on 1 January 2021
- He was appointed Chief Prosecutor in the Attorney-General's Chambers in 2013.
- Mr Tai obtained an MPhil in criminology from the University of Cambridge in 2009, focussing on violence research, in particular, historical levels of homicide in Singapore.
- He obtained his undergraduate law degree from the University of Oxford, where he also obtained the postgraduate degree of Bachelor of Civil Law.
- He trained and qualified in London as a solicitor with an international law firm, and is called to the New York Bar.
- He joined the Singapore Legal Service in 1999 as a Justices' Law Clerk.
- He later served as a Deputy Public Prosecutor, and Assistant Registrar of the Supreme Court.
- In addition, he has held a number of appointments in the Singapore Public Service, including Deputy Secretary of the Ministry of Home Affairs.
