

## **Biographical note**

### **David Antonyshyn**

#### **Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions, Public Prosecution Service of Canada**

Since November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018, David Antonyshyn is one of the two Deputy Directors of Public Prosecutions with the Public Prosecution Service of Canada (PPSC). He is responsible for the PPSC's regional offices in Alberta, Atlantic Canada, the National Capital Region, Quebec, Saskatchewan and Yukon. He previously served as a military lawyer within the Canadian Armed Forces, including as the Assistant Director of the Canadian Military Prosecution Service. He retired with the rank of Colonel.

A 1995 graduate from the *Université de Montréal* Law School, he was admitted to the Québec Bar in 1996 after having articulated as a prosecutor in criminal and penal law. David holds a Master of Laws degree (LL.M.) from the University of Ottawa's Faculty of Law, where he focused on issues of international human rights law, the law of armed conflict/international humanitarian law, and international criminal law.
