Synopsis:

The presentation is about the alternatives to prosecution like:

1. **PLEA BARGAINING:** Where an accused can plea his guilt and bargain for lesser punishment as per Criminal Procedure Code of India. Different types of Plea bargain available in LAW
2. **COMPOUNDING THE OFFENSES:** Where the offenses are compounded with or without the approval of the Courts.
3. **ARBITRATION:** Withdrawal of the Prosecution when the Victim and the Accused arrives at consensus.
4. **COMPENSATION:** Courts may order offenders to pay such compensation as the court thinks reasonable for loss or injury caused to any person by the commission of the offences.
5. **PROBATION:** Probation is one of the outstanding non-custodial measures which is designed to work for early reformation and re-socialization of criminals while they remain in the communities as ordinary citizens by subjecting them to certain conditions with which they must comply.
