

CV of Gilles CHARBONNIER

Gilles CHARBONNIER is for 2013 deputy general prosecutor at the Appeal Court of Paris, in charge of implementation, coordination and control of the judicial policies within the prosecution services depending of the court and also the design of the international policy of the Prosecutor General. Previously, he supervised the organized crime, public health and environment sectors. He is born on the 22nd August 1962, is married and has three children. After his academic studies where he got a master degree in law and his scholarship in the French National School for the Judiciary, he is appointed in 1989 as deputy prosecutor of CHALON SUR SAONE. During his career, he has been appointed in a various range of positions : in the ministry of justice (within the department of extradition and mutual legal assistance), in the ministry of work and social affairs (in the department of the contractual relationships between employers and employees) , in the national school for the judiciary (the ENM where he was in charge of continuous training and partnerships within the E.U) and in the general inspectorate of the judiciary (where he was in charge among others of the international department). He has been Secretary General of the European Judicial Training Network (EJTN) from 2005 until 2008 where he designed and implemented the Exchange Program of judges and prosecutors within the E.U. Before his current position, he was deputy prosecutor in the first instance court of EVRY (2010-2013). He is officer of the National Merit Order and treasurer of the International Association of Francophone Public Prosecutors.
