

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PROSECUTORS (IAP)
AND
THE KOREAN PROSECUTION SERVICE
DATED: THE 25 OF JUNE 2011

The Korean Prosecution Service (“the Host”) and the International Association of Prosecutors (IAP) (together, “the Parties”) have the responsibility to facilitate a successful operation of the upcoming 16th IAP Annual Conference through enhanced cooperation and in accordance with the IAP rules and standards.

For the upcoming 16th IAP Annual Conference, the Parties will offer a very reasonable registration fee to encourage as much participation as possible. The parties have agreed upon the following in order to benefit the IAP as well as the Host through adequate distribution of the income from registration fee.

1. The registration fee has been decided as €500 (\$680 USD) for early bird rate, and €600 (\$820 USD) for standard rate. Due to the lowered registration fee, the Host will pay \$85 USD per participant to the IAP according to the IAP Protocol.
2. The Parties shall exempt the beneficiaries of the Grant Program and the participants from the Korean Prosecution Service from payment of registration fees.
3. In case the number of total participants is less than 400, which is approximately the average number of participants for the past 15 IAP Annual Conferences, the Host will pay a total of 20% of the registration fee income to the IAP. This is to guarantee the minimum income by reimbursing IAP for any losses caused by lower registration fee.

4. The Host will cover the airfare and accommodation of the IAP President, Secretary-General, General-Counsel, and former IAP President, Nicholas Cowdery AM QC, who will be receiving the Medal of Honor, for the trip to attend the upcoming 16th IAP Annual Conference and the 4th World Summit of Prosecutors General, Attorneys General & Chief Prosecutors with the income from the registration fee.
5. The Host will also cover the accommodation for the former Secretary-General, Henk Marquart Scholtz.
6. The Host will run an Invitation Program for up to 10 participants who are to attend the 16th IAP Annual Conference for special purpose or are having financial difficulties. The Host will select the beneficiaries in consultation with the IAP, and bear the costs for accommodation and/or airfare from the registration fee income. This is a friendly proposal suggested by Joon Gyu Kim as the IAP Vice-President.
7. This Agreement will enter into force on the date it is signed and shall remain in force until the payment is completed. If either party wishes to modify any terms mentioned above, the party must consult with the other party upon 30 days notice to reach a new agreement.

This Agreement is signed on the 25 of June, 2011 during the Executive Meeting of the IAP held in Seoul, Korea.


