



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN: The International Network to Promote the Rule of Law

(INPROL)

AND: The International Association of Prosecutors (IAP)

DATED: The 20th day of March 2008

The IAP

The IAP has been established since 1995 and is the first and only worldwide organisation for prosecutors with membership in over 130 countries.

On 21 May 2000, it was granted special consultative status to the Economic and Social Committee of the United Nations.

The Objects of the IAP are set out in its Constitution and include the following:-

- (e) to assist prosecutors internationally in the fight against organised or other crime, and for that purpose:
 - to promote international co-operation in gathering and providing evidence; in tracking, seizing and forfeiting the proceeds of serious crime; and in the prosecution of fugitive criminals; to promote speed and efficiency in such international co-operation;
- (h) to promote good relations between individual prosecutors and prosecution agencies; to facilitate the exchange and dissemination among them of information, expertise and experience; and, to that end, to encourage the use of information technology;

- (5) explore mutual opportunities to actively participate in events and conferences arranged by each organisation.
- (6) advertise this Memorandum of Understanding in the newsletter and website of each organisation, as appropriate.

This Memorandum of Understanding will enter into force on the date it is made and will remain in force until varied in writing upon review by consent between the parties. It can be terminated by either party upon 30 days notice. The maintenance and review of this Memorandum of Understanding will be the responsibility of the Co-Directors of INPROL and the General Counsel of the IAP. The terms of this Memorandum of Understanding should be reviewed within 2 years of the date it is made.
